Highly automated processes for ESG regulations

Sustainability is a key issue for the Optima Group. In line with its mission "We care for people", the focus is on holistic responsibility along the supply chain and towards employees. In this case, the focus on sustainability means, above all, responsibility with regard to ESG (environmental, social and corporate governance) issues. This issue is becoming increasingly important due

to the obligation to comply with various EU regulations such as the Supply Chain Due Diligence Act (LkSG), the Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM) and the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD). The individual regulations require comprehensive transparency and reporting along the entire supply chain. In particular, documenting environmental impacts and social standards in the supply chain poses a significant challenge, as a large amount of data has to be processed. In order to comply with the regulations and to avoid legal consequences, it is essential to check the information. If suppliers fail to meet certain requirements, such as working conditions, severe penalties and a loss of reputation may result. Many of the processes for data collection, consolidation and reporting already exist at the Optima Group. However, they cannot cover the manual workload that arises from the regulations.

Optima uses osapiens to simplify reporting

The Optima Group was looking for a suitable solution to meet the requirements of the EU regulations as efficiently and transparently as possible. "When we were faced with the challenge of meeting the legal requirements, we wanted to use a tool that would support us in doing so," says Dominik Meyer, Sustainability Manager at Optima materials management GmbH. They chose the platform solution, the osapiens HUB, with the solutions for the Supply Chain Due Diligence Act (LkSG), the Car-



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bon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM) and the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD). “We face challenges in terms of sustainability. The CSRD and the LKSG are very important issues for us. osapiens offers very good solutions in this area,” says Meyer. We were assigned an osapiens project manager, and our employees and I as the project manager, received personal training in the product.”
