### Initial Situation & Challenges

Mister Spex is one of Germany's leading opticians, combining a strong e-commerce business with an expanding retail store network. The company operates across multiple countries and integrates digital and physical customer experiences.

Before implementing the osapiens HUB Reporting Cockpit, Mister Spex managed sustainability-related data in a fragmented setup across multiple systems and departments. This led to data silos, high manual effort, and inconsistent data structures, limiting transparency and making reliable reporting difficult. With the introduction of CSRD and ESRS, requirements increased significantly.

Mister Spex needed to conduct a Double Materiality Assessment (DMA), ensure consistent and audit-ready sustainability data, and consolidate cross-functional inputs from Finance, HR, and Operations. In parallel, the company had to prepare for external audits and stricter regulatory scrutiny. These requirements directly affected Sustainability, Finance, Controlling, and operational teams, which now had to align more closely on data, processes, and responsibilities.

With the osapiens HUB Reporting Cockpit, Mister Spex established a centralized platform to structure sustainability data and reporting processes. This also enables a streamlined Double Materiality Assessment (DMA) in the future, integrating cross-functional input and standardized evaluation of impacts, risks, and opportunities. Transparent documentation ensures audit readiness, while the results provided clear prioritization of material topics and a solid basis for strategic decision-making.
